Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that we are having a visit from Lee Collinson-James, the skip-hop coach, for a day of skipping on the 24th May. Every child in the school will have the opportunity to take part in one of the workshops taking place throughout the day in which they will learn a selection of moves, including individual moves, double-dutch, long rope, and partner skipping from one of the country's leading skipping coaches. To finish the day off there will be a floorshow of the skills learned during the day, performed by children chosen from each workshop.

By inviting skip-hop, the school hopes to encourage children and adults to skip for fun and fitness, and to re-introduce traditional skipping games back into the school lunchtime activities.

The cost of the day is £6.50 per child and the children will need their PE kits / tracksuits and suitable footwear (trainers or plimsolls - no bare feet). Please note that all skipping ropes will be provided to this activity.

In addition, on the day speed-skipping ropes will be on sale (on the day only) and the prices are as follows:

- Children's £4
- Adult £5
- Family £6
- Xtenders £2
- Double Dutch £10 per pair
